

7th Grade Suggested Supply List

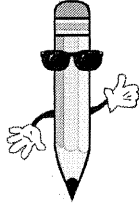
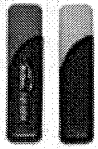
Dear Parent/Guardians,

(Bring to classes each day):

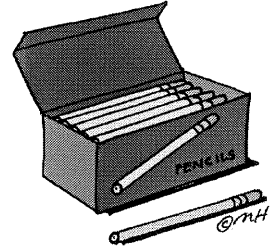
- Pencils, Pencils, Pencils!

FOR SPECIFIC CLASSES

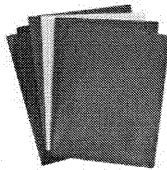
MATH
