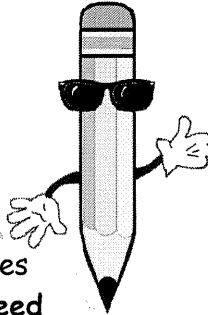
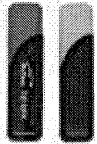
Dear Parent/Guardians,

(Bring to classes each day):

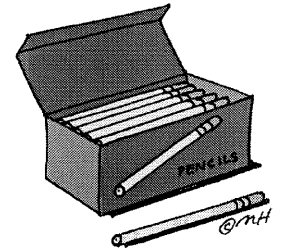
- Pencils, Pencils, Pencils!

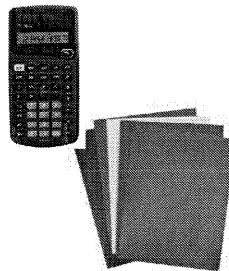

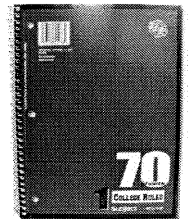

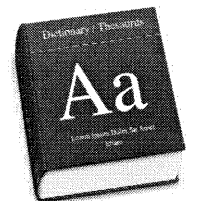
- Spanish Dictionary (REQUIRED)
