# ***Student/Athlete Academic & Citizenship Requirements & Responsibilities***

- Each athlete **MUST** have a current physical on file **BEFORE** the first practice or tryout. A physical is considered current if it was given on or after April 15 of the **previous** school year.
- Each athlete **MUST** be passing all classes-those having difficulty are given an opportunity to bring their grade(s) up.
- Weekly academic checks are conducted.
- Anyone having difficulty academically are monitored via a Weekly Progress Report.
- If no improvement is made, the student becomes ineligible for the following week.
- If improvement is still not made, he or she is removed from the team.

# ***Student/Athlete Academic & Citizenship Requirements & Responsibilities (continued.)***

- **Citizenship/Conduct Marks (1 – 5) are issued at mid and end of marking periods. An average is then determined from all issuing teachers.**
- **Athletes receiving an AVERAGE of 3 or greater immediately become ineligible (no practicing or participating in athletic contests) the following week.**
- **After one week the athlete's citizenship/conduct is reevaluated.**
- **The athlete must be present in school at least 1/2 day to participate in games.**
- **An athlete serving a suspension may not practice or participate in an athletic contest during the duration of the suspension.**

***Student/Athlete  
Academic & Citizenship  
Requirements & Responsibilities (continued)***

- **Parents wishing to take their child home after an away game, MUST sign their child out with a coach.**
- **Athletes are responsible for replacing any equipment or uniforms not turned in at the end of the season. Athletes will not be allowed to try out for the next sport until the equipment is turned in or paid for.**

# ***Communication***

- **Notify coaches of any schedule conflicts in advance.**
- **Concerns appropriate to discuss with coaches:**
  - **How your child is progressing**
  - **Ways to help your child improve**
  - **Concerns about your child's behavior**
- **Concerns inappropriate to discuss with coaches:**
  - **Play Calling**
  - **Substitution Patterns**
  - **Other Student Athletes**
  - **If there are concerns, please don't address them immediately following a game when emotions are high. Set up an appointment to meet with the coach if needed.**
