

Information regarding 9th – 11th grade DANCE Auditions for the Pankow Performing Dance program

On Friday, February 11th – 12:48 - 2:05 pm at Pankow

TAKE THE 6TH HOUR BUS TO PANKOW!

All dance classes are full year classes for a two hour block at Pankow
Classes count for a 0.5 Phys ed credit and a 1.0 Performing Arts credit

Beginner dance students do NOT need to audition and should sign up for Dance 1.
Only one section of Dance 1 is offered and is a popular class so it is possible that some students who sign up for Dance 1 will not have it on their schedule.
Please choose alternate classes in case this should occur.

Students interested in Dance 2 or 3: Intermediate/Advanced Dance will need to perform an audition:

Intermediate and Advanced dance auditions will consist of the following:

Students take the Pankow Bus to 6th Hour class at Pankow and meet at the Pankow Dance Studio

All dance students should be prepared to move, learn a basic routine, and perform it at that time.

They will also be asked to do a few dance steps in place or across the floor.
Once they finish their audition they stay, observe the Dance 3 class and take the Pankow Bus back to their school with the Dance 3 students.

CURRENT 9th-11th grade students may audition for the Dance 2 intermediate and the Dance 3 advanced dance class.

Requirements: Students are required to supply their own leotard, tights, and tan jazz Shoes.

Placement into Dance 2 or Dance 3 is by audition only!
