ACADEMY AND AEC STUDENT STANDARDS

The following standards apply to all students attending the L'Anse Creuse/Mount Clemens Alternative Education Program.

ATTENDANCE:

Students are expected to attend classes on scheduled days and follow attendance rules as listed in the Student Handbook

CLASSROOM PRODUCTIVITY:

Students must complete a minimum of 56 hours of instructional time in class plus complete all course requirements. Students must complete all assigned work with an 80% mastery level.

Students are required to complete requirements for each class in which they are enrolled and present their work to the instructor in a timely fashion.

Students must maintain good attendance.

Students sleeping in class will be marked absent

ATTITUDE AND BEHAVIOR:

Students will conduct themselves in an adult manner and have respect for all students, staff and visitors.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

The use of radios, CD player or MPs in the building is allowed only when headphones are used and only at the discretion of the instructor.

Cell phones and/or pagers are not allowed on school property.

DRESS CODE:
