

## Tardiness and Attendance

There are five minutes to exchange classes. Three student tardies in a month will result in a student detention. Regular daily attendance is important for student achievement and success at LCHS.

## Student Transportation

Students are to be seated, interact respectfully, and follow all directions of driver. Eating or drinking on the bus is not allowed. Violations can lead to removal from bus and other consequences.

## Sportsmanship

Positive sportsmanship is expected at **all** extracurricular activities. Cheer **your** team. No negative comments about opposing teams, their fans, cheerleaders, or referees.

## Performing Arts Center

At any performance or assembly, students are to be quiet and respectful of all others. Stay in your seat, unless there is an emergency. Display appropriate applause without obnoxious yelling/whistling.

## Homework Requests

Requests for student's homework can be processed when a student is absent three or more days from school. Please notify the office if you are in need of a homework request.

## General Student Guidelines

- Students are never to be out of the classroom without a signed pass/planner.
- Students should have their identification on them at all times.
- Appropriate behavior is expected at all extra-curricular activities in or out of the building.
- When returning from Pankow, students are to wait quietly in the entry way until the bell rings.
- Do not litter in the parking lot or on school grounds.
- Backpacks and bags can be used to and from school only. They are not allowed to be carried during the school day.
- Only water is allowed in the classrooms.
- No one is to enter the locker rooms without staff escort. All gym lockers must be locked at all times, no exceptions. LCHS is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Students are responsible for the contents of their locker and should never leave it unlocked.
- The breakfast program in the cafeteria closes at 7:06 a.m.
- Students should respect one another and appreciate their unique gifts, differences & abilities.
- Student cell phones must be turned off and/or silent during school hours.
- The Commons and Media Center Areas are open and supervised until 3:00 daily.
- Students should get involved in the multitude of activities, clubs and athletics teams available at LCHS.

## Dress Code

One of our goals is to prepare students for the world after school. We find when our students dress in a business fashion, they tend to conduct themselves in a more business-like manner. Since school is their workplace/business, we require students to follow the High School Dress Code which is based entirely upon the L'Anse Creuse Public Schools Dress Code.

- Shirts with sleeves and which cover the midriff are to be worn in school.
  - ◆ No tank tops, no halter tops
  - ◆ No showing of undergarments
- Pants are to be worn at the waist.
  - ◆ No pajama or leisure pants
  - ◆ No showing of undergarments
- Skirts or shorts must be at least mid-thigh length.
  - ◆ No short shorts, gym shorts, mini-skirts
- Shoes and/or boots are to be worn in school.
  - ◆ No bedroom/house slippers
- Clothing depicting drugs, alcohol, violence, racism, sex, tobacco and profanity are not acceptable in school.
- Bandanas, spiked jewelry, and chains are not allowed in school.

If any student is deemed not within the dress code by LCPS administration, the student will be directed to change. He/she may contact a parent/guardian for different clothing or will be sent home. Additionally, the student will be issued a detention by the Dean of Students.

## Smoking/Alcohol/Drugs

- Smoking is not allowed for anyone in school or in the "Smoke Free School Zone".
- Students should not be in possession of any tobacco products or contraband.
- LCHS is a "Drug Free School Zone."
- Failure to adhere to the policies above will result in disciplinary action at the school level. The Macomb County Sheriff will be contacted to initiate an investigation.

## Closed Campus Lunch Room

- All students will be asked to report to the lunch room during their assigned lunch period.
- Students must stay seated, except when in line. Keep seating to one student per seat.
- Interact positively in a low tone of voice.
- Stay away from serving area when not in line.
- Use manners and treat cafeteria staff with respect.
- Clean up your area within the last five minutes of the lunch period. Dispose of trash properly.
- No food or beverage leaves the cafeteria.

## Cell Phones

Cell phones are disruptive to the educational process and are **not to be seen or heard** in any location between 7:11 a.m. and 2:20 p.m. In addition, cell phone use is not allowed any time in the bathrooms or locker room area, including before and after school.

When the above rules are broken, refusal from a student to turn over their phone to a staff member will result in disciplinary action. Cell phones may be returned at the close of the school day on the 1st incident and the student will receive a detention from the Dean of Students. For repeated incidences, progressive discipline will follow.



## Detention Expectations

- Detention can be assigned for violating the code of conduct and not following expectations.
- Detention will be served in a designated area from 2:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Double Detentions will be served from 1:30-3:30 on Wednesdays (Early Release).
- Students will sign in and be assigned a seat.
- No sleeping in detention.
- Talking or interaction with other students is not allowed in detention.
- Lateness, skipping, or violating detention expectations will lead to progressive discipline (additional day of detention/parent contact, etc).

## Student Parking Lot

- A valid driver's license and proof of insurance are required to register for a parking pass.
- Parking pass must be permanently attached to the lower driver's side of the windshield.
- Only vehicles with a parking pass should enter the LCHS parking lot.
- Parking lot speed limit is 10 mph.
- Music should be off or at a very low volume while in the parking lot.
- Students should drive very slowly and cautiously in the parking lot. Be extremely aware of other vehicles, students, and staff in the parking lot.
- Careless/reckless driving and not following expectations can lead to loss of parking privileges.
- Seniors and Juniors may park only in the **front** lot. Sophomores and Freshman are not allowed to drive to school without the approval from an administrator.
