Registration Process:

Each student seeking enrollment in FreshStart begins with an initial orientation with an administrator or his designee. During this process, program guidelines are clearly discussed to determine whether FreshStart is a good fit for the student. In addition, the registration paperwork is thoroughly reviewed and parent questions or concerns are addressed.

All students entering Riverside Academy must go through a general orientation. For FreshStart students, this can be done either before or after your registration meeting, but must be completed prior to joining class.
