<p>Kindergarten</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 large backpack without wheels • 1 box of tissues • 6-10 glue sticks • 2 or more boxes of 24 count Crayola Crayons • Dry Eraser markers and eraser • Crayola Markers • Elmer's Glue Bottle • 1 pair Fiskar Scissors 	<p>Third Grade</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red Pen • Crayons- no larger than the 32 count • Pack of glue sticks • 2 EXPO dry erase odorless markers in black or blue • Spiral notebook- 8 1/2 X 11 one subject, not college ruled, 70 count • Pencils (no mechanical) • Two Boxes of Kleenex • Ziploc baggies (any size) • Black medium tip thin marker (no permanent markers) • Pencil box or pouch (approx. 5x8 size, no larger please) • Erasers <p>***Any extra donations of above supplies will be put towards our classroom. Also, students will have chair pockets, so please avoid bulky items, especially oversized folders and pencil boxes.</p>
<p>Frist Grade</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 large backpack – large enough to hold a lunch box, folder and other day-to-day items your child will be transporting to and from school. For safety reasons, we ask that you purchase a backpack that does not have wheels. • 6 glue sticks • 1 pair Fiskar scissors • 24 pack of crayons • 2 pink pearl erasers • 2 boxes Kleenex • 3 dry erase markers (black only – fat markers) • 1 bottle Elmer's glue • 1 container Clorox wipes <p>Velcro tennis shoes – only if your child does not know how to tie their own shoes. First grade teachers will not tie shoes and feel it is unsafe for children to walk around with their shoes untied.</p>	<p>Fourth Grade</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Red Pen • Crayons- no larger than the 32 count • Pack of glue sticks • 2 EXPO dry erase odorless markers in black or blue • Spiral notebook- 8 1/2 X 11 one subject, not college ruled, 70 count • Pencils (no mechanical) • Two Boxes of Kleenex • Ziploc baggies-Boys bring in freezer size and girls bring in sandwich size bags • Black medium tip thin marker (no permanent markers) • Pencil box or pouch (approx. 5x8 size, no larger please) • Erasers <p>***Any extra donations of above supplies will be put towards our classroom. <p>Second Grade</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sharpened pencils • Crayons • Colored pencils (Crayola) • Eraser • 8Glue sticks • Pencil box (snaps shut) • Pencil/crayon sharpener • 2 large boxes of Kleenex • Book bag <p>Several packs of crayons in packages of 24 or 48 per box are better than one large box. This way your child can replenish crayons throughout the year. Crayola brand colored pencils sharpen well and last longer.</p> <p>Ask your child weekly or monthly about his/her supply (allow about 1 pencil per 2 weeks and 1 glue stick per month)</p> <p>Extras for class sharing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Zipper bags any size • Glue sticks • Crayola colored pencils • Wet Wipes for desk cleaning 	<p>Fifth Grade</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1 large bookbag • 7 pocket folders w/prongs in center (different colors) • 2 pocket folders without prongs, any color • 3 black & white journal-type composition books • 1 pkg. Notebook paper, wide-ruled • 1 80 pg spiral notebook, wide-ruled • 1 pkg insert dividers, 5 tabs • 1 pkg index cards, 3x5 • 1 pair scissors • 1 ruler, inches and centimeters • 1 - 24 count colored pencils • 1 – 24 or 48 count crayons • 1 bottle glue and 4 glue sticks • 2 pkgs. Posti-it notes • 2 highlighters (different colors) • 1 doz. #2 pencils (erasers too) • 2 boxes Kleenex • 1 bottle hand sanitizer • 1 box Ziploc baggies, quart size • 12 count markers (optional) • 1 bottle white-out (optional)
