

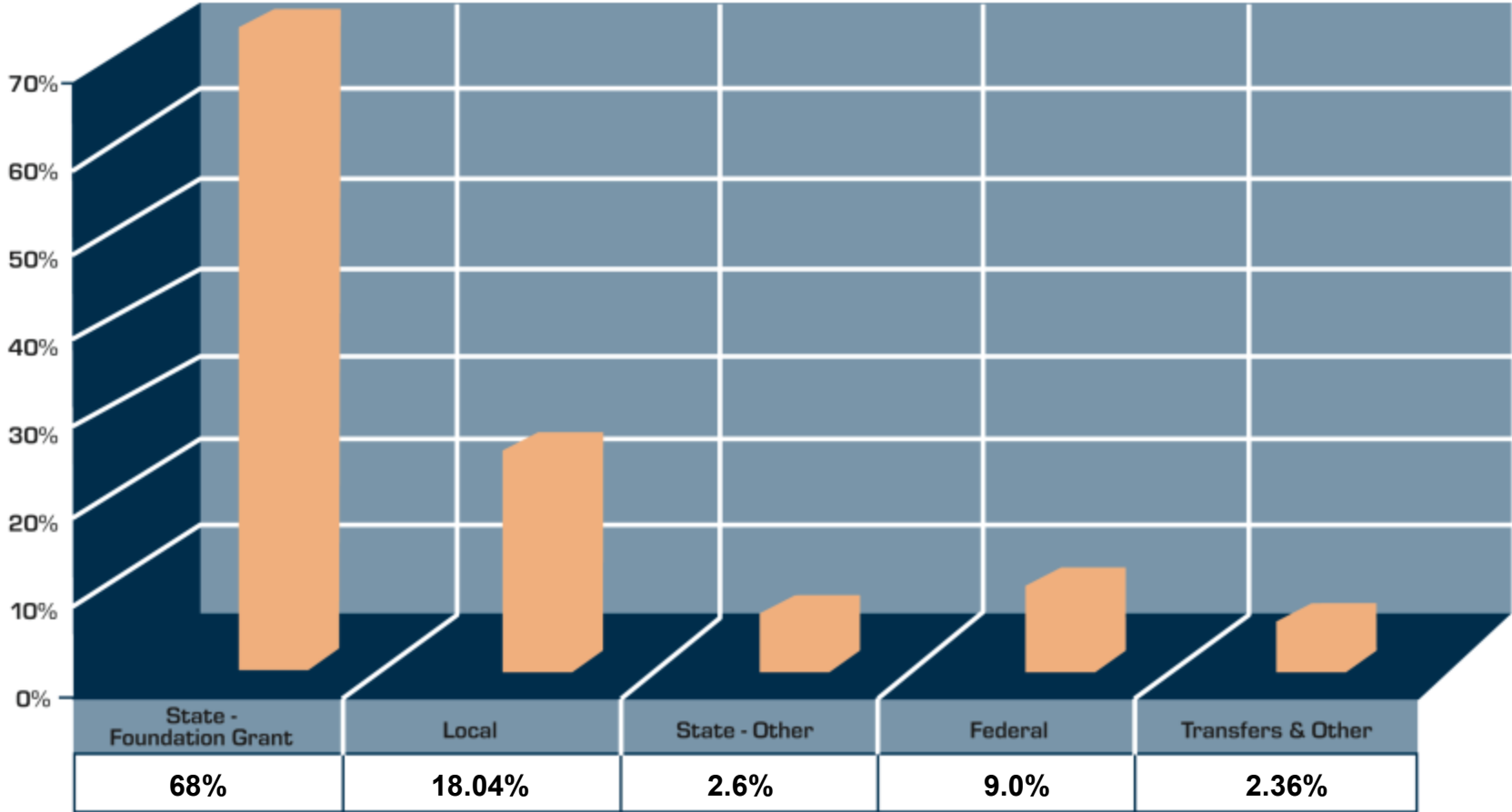
# **Funding Education**

In Michigan, public school districts receive a sum of money from the state called a foundation grant. The amount of this grant is different for each district. In the L'Anse Creuse Public Schools' district, the foundation grant accounted for approximately **82.4 percent** of the district's income.

The district also receives local funding from sources including the 18 mills levied on non-homestead properties and various grants. The district receives **18.04 percent** of its funds from local revenues.

While the district does receive federal funds accounting for **9.0 percent** of its income, these monies are earmarked for specific programs and are in the form of grants.
