The state of Michigan's accreditation system is called Education YES!

Michigan School Report Cards

In 2002, the State Board of Education approved Education YES!, A Yardstick for Excellent Schools. Michigan's school accreditation system is based on standards and measures school performance and student achievement. One-third of the report includes the results of the building self-assessment, which includes 40 School Performance Indicators. Two-thirds of the report focuses on the MEAP and measures student achievement.

Each school receives a letter grade of A, B, C, D, or F in each of four categories. One letter is given for Achievement Status, one for Achievement Change, and one for Indicators of School Performance. Each category counts as one-third of the final composite letter grade.

Comprehensive Needs Assessment

The Comprehensive Needs Assessment is based on such elements as curriculum alignment, performance management systems, teacher quality, extended learning opportunities, advanced course work, family involvement, facilities, and an education/employment plan.

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)

is part of the Michigan accreditation system. It is the measure used in the area of Reading and Math to determine student achievement based on the MEAP. We are proud to report that all but two of our buildings have made adequate yearly progress as determined by the Michigan Department of Education.

In order for a school to meet its AYP requirements, 95 percent of its students must take the MEAP test, and the percentage of students in the proficient categories must meet or exceed the cutoff percentages determined by the state.
