The facility will address the increasing demand for additional instructional, athletic, and extracurricular spaces. It will also reduce rental costs currently paid by the school district to host graduation ceremonies, staff training, and student events.

About the proposed Multi-use Facility

The multi-use facility will have instructional rooms, storage spaces, restrooms, and a secure entrance. It will provide flexible spaces for large and small group instructional programs such as the Science Olympiad, the robotics program, staff professional development, and space to support the Career Technical Education (CTE) programs.

The multi-use facility will also support the LCPS athletic programs and provide athletic spaces for practice and competition for tennis, pickleball, soccer, football, basketball, volleyball, batting and pitching cages, and a track.

By consolidating these functions within a multi-use facility, the school district will enhance its operational efficiency, create a learning environment that fosters student and staff collaboration, and support arts and athletic programs.
