COVID-19 Guidelines and Testing Information

Please use the following information as a guideline from the Macomb County Health Department:

- Monitor for any symptoms of COVID-19. If your child test positive or develops symptoms, keep them home for at least 5 days after the start of symptoms, they are fever-free, and symptoms improve.
- Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea.
- If you are concerned about any potential exposure to your student(s) or family, please see the information below for free COVID testing in the district.

NO COST COVID TESTING OPPORTUNITY

If you or your students are interested in testing after being in close contact or developing symptoms of COVID-19, the district has partnered with Northshore Clinical Labs to conduct free COVID-19 test. The testing is at the Pellerin Center located at 24001 F.V. Pankow Boulevard in Clinton Township. The testing schedule is Monday through Friday from 3:00 – 7:00 pm and Sunday 12:00 -7:00 pm.

- Arrive during testing hours, receive results within 15 minutes of testing
- Parents must register their students
- Both the Rapid and PCR test will be administered
- Test results will be emailed to you
