Macomb County Emergency HOME Tenant Based Rental Assistacnce

About the Program

The Macomb County Emergency HOME Tenant Based Rental Assistance (TBRA) Program provides financial assistance to low income individuals and families in Macomb County who are experiencing a financial hardship due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The program will potentially provide security deposit, rental arrears, rent subsidy and utility (limited to heating (gas and deliverable fuels), electric and water) subsidy through September 30, 2021 to qualifying applications. Completed applications will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.

Eligibility

1. Residency: Macomb County Resident

Funds cannot be used to assist anyone whose last known address is in St. Clair Shores or Warren

2. Gross Household Income at or less than 60% AMI

Age Eligibility: Students under age 24 do not qualify as low-income household unless the student is independently eligible or a member of income eligible household or a veteran, married, or has dependent child.

3. Financial Hardship Due to COVID-19

- Loss of income due to reduction of paid work hours due to COVID-19 (examples: laid off, loss of hours, income reduction, etc.);
- Loss of income due to sickness with COVID-19 or caring for a household/family member who is/was sick with COVID-19
- Loss of income due to compliance with a recommendation from a government health authority to stay home, self-quarantine, or avoid congregating with others during the state of emergency
- Loss of income due to other factors resulting from the COVID-19 emergency
- Homelessness caused by or prolonged due to the COVID-19 pandemic
