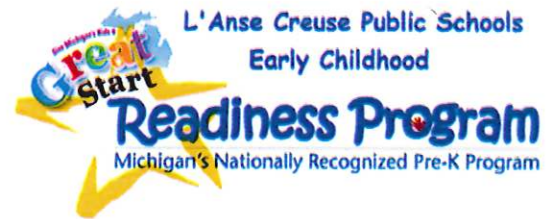

The Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) is a state funded preschool program for children who will be 4 on or before September 1, 2024 and whose families meet or come close to the income criteria. Classes are Monday through Friday Full Day (7 hrs.).

This is a **tuition free** program.
