#### ***Students Not Feeling Well***

Please contact the LCHS Attendance Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. If your student tests positive for Covid-19, access online the [Covid-19 Reporting Form](#). Once you have submitted the information for your student, a notification will be sent to Pam Brooks, LCPS CDC Rep and to LCHS. You do not need to call to report that your student has tested positive for Covid-19. Absences will be marked based on the information provided in the reporting form.

**Thursday, March 9th** is a Half Day of School for students. Students will report to hour 3 & 4 and dismissal will be at 10:30am. Please make sure a ride is secured for your student, as the building will

be closed after dismissal while we prepare for Parent/Teacher Conferences.

### ***Visitors During School Hours***

### ***Painted Parking Spots***

If your student drives to/from school and does not have a painted parking spot, please remind them to not park in a spot that is painted. A spot that is painted belongs to a Senior student and is considered their parking spot for the school year. If a Senior that has a parking spot painted finds another vehicle has parked in their spot, please have your student report this to the Main Office. We appreciate your help.

### ***Staff Parking Lot***

As a reminder, the back parking lot is reserved for **STAFF ONLY Monday-Friday 5:30am-3:00pm.** Parent/Students are prohibited from using this parking lot during these days/times. Violators may be subject to ticketing.

### ***Parent Drop-Off/Pick-Up***

Parents, please take a moment to review the **STUDENT DROP-OFF & PICK-UP PROCEDURES** effective immediately. For the safety of all students, staff & parents, your cooperation with following these procedures is greatly appreciated. Individuals not following these procedures are subject to ticketing.

### ***Parking Permits***

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$30.00 & are processed electronically only. In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the following. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued.

- Login to [Payschools](#) to pay for your parking permit
- Access the [22-23 Parking Permit Form](#), completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the students driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.

- The parking permit will be distributed to your student during school once it is processed.

### ***LCHS Athletic Event Policies-**PLEASE REVIEW!*****

Please make sure to review the policies/rules for all Athletic Events in the "CLUBS/ATHLETICS" Section.

- **ALL STUDENTS MUST** have their student ID to enter any Athletic Event (or any building event outside of normal school hours). **NO ID=NO ENTRY.**
- There is an entry fee for all Athletic Events. The entry fee is for adults & students. **If your student is denied entry, they are expected to leave the premises.**
- Building entry for Athletic Events is through the front of the building only. If a spectator parks in the back parking lot, they must walk around to the front of the building for entry.

- Children under high school age **WILL NOT** will be permitted into events unless accompanied by an adult.
- The adult is expected to stay for the entire event.

### ***LCHS Athletic Passes/Admission Prices***

There is a \$5 admission fee for all events. Children under the age of 10 & Adults age 62 & over are free. Athletic Passes from school year 21-22 are not accepted. Passes are currently available for purchase through [Payschools](#).

### ***Away Game Admission Policies***

- Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online **BEFORE** the event.
- Students are **REQUIRED** to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools **WILL NOT** accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

### ***Sports Physicals***

Physical forms can be found on the [LC Athletics Website](#). A sports physical is considered valid if a parent/guardian signature appears in sections 2,3 & 4. **NOTE: Students must have a Sports Physical dated after April 15, 2022 in order to participate in sports for the School Year 22-23.**

**Class of 2023** graduation requirement is 25 hours\*

- **100 Hours must be turned in by March 3, 2023** to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours must be turned in by April 14, 2023** to receive Honor Cord
- **25 Hours must be turned in by April 28, 2023** to receive Diploma

**Class of 2024** graduation requirement is 30 hours\*

**Class of 2025** graduation requirement is 40 hours

**Class of 2026** graduation requirement is 40 hours
