#### Pankow Buses In The Morning

There are 5 Buses available to take students over to Pankow in the morning. Each bus will leave as soon as they are filled, with the last bus leaving LCHS promptly at 7:04am. Students that miss the bus will have to have a parent/guardian drive them to Pankow. If a student does not have a ride, they can sit in the Commons and the parent will have to call their absence into Pankow at 586-783-6570. Driving passes for students will not be issued, as LCPS is a closed campus during school hours.

#### **Parking Permits**

In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the following. Payment and all of the required information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued.

- The parking permit will be distributed to your student during school once it is processed.
