Class of 2023 graduation requirement is 25 hours*

- **100 Hours** must be turned in by March 3, 2023 to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours** must be turned in by April 14, 2023 to receive Honor Cord
- **25 Hours** must be turned in by April 28, 2023 to receive Diploma

Class of 2024 graduation requirement is 30 hours*

Class of 2025 graduation requirement is 40 hours

Class of 2026 graduation requirement is 40 hours

All hours are due by the end of the student's senior year or will be subject to a diploma hold.

PSAT/NMSQT Test
