GENERAL INFORMATION:

First Day Of School

The first day of school is **Tuesday**, **September 5th and is a Half Day**. School starts at 7:11am and students will be released at 10:30am. All students will report to homeroom before 1st hour. Please access the <u>Homeroom Schedule</u> to see where your student will report before 1st hour. Homeroom schedules will also be posted throughout the building on the first day of school. Staff Parking Lot

As a reminder, the back parking lot (along the baseball & football fields) is reserved for **STAFF ONLY Monday-Friday 5:30am-3:00p**m. Parent/Students are prohibited from using this parking lot during these days/times. Violators are subject to ticketing.

Student Drop-Off/Pick-Up Procedure

Please review the procedures for <u>Drop-Off</u> & <u>Pick-Up</u> for before and after school. Drop-Off & Pick-Up is strictly prohibited in the Staff Parking Lot. We appreciate your cooperation.

Visitors To The Building

All visitors to LCHS **MUST** enter the building through the front doors into the Commons at all times. During school hours, visitors must present a valid driver's license or state id to enter the building beyond the Commons. Visitors will be issued a visitor's pass and must turn it back into the receptionist before exiting the building. We appreciate your cooperation.

Textbook Distribution

Students will receive their textbooks the first week of school. Details for distribution are being finalized and students will be given direction on how to pick up their textbooks. Students will need their student ID with them to be issued textbooks. If your student does not have an ID yet, they can provide a copy of their class schedule.

Student Chromebooks

If you have a student that has not yet been issued a Chromebook, students can see Mrs. Feld in the Commons during their lunch beginning Wednesday, September 6th – Friday, September 8th. Students will need their student ID, along with the <u>School District</u> <u>Issued Device Agreement For Parents/Guardians and</u> <u>Students Form</u> in order to be issued a Chromebook. If your student does not have an ID yet, they can provide a copy of their class schedule.

Another reminder! Don't forget to purchase Student Device Insurance for your student's chromebook! Insurance that was purchased for school year 22-23 expires on September 4th. The deadline to purchase insurance for school year 23-24 for your student's device is October 15, 2023. Logon to <u>Smart</u> <u>Tech</u> to purchase your insurance.

Schedule Change Requests

A reminder that the deadline to submit a schedule change request is **Friday**, **September 8th by 3:00pm**. All requests must be submitted online to the student's counselor. Logon to the <u>LCHS Website</u> and scroll to "Schedule Change Requests" to submit your request.

Medication Drop-Off

If your child will be taking medication during school hours that will need to be administered by LCHS staff, please email our Medical Aide, <u>Mrs. Perkins</u> to schedule an appointment for drop-off. As a reminder, **ALL** medication (prescription and nonprescription) **MUST** be dropped off by a parent/guardian. In addition, required forms must be completed and on file at LCHS before we are able to administer any medication to a student. Forms can be obtained from Mrs. Perkins.

Most schools WILL NOT accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

Name Verification For Graduation Diplomas

If your senior has not already done, please make sure they access the <u>Name Verification Form</u> to submit their information. **NOTE: students must enter their name** in the form exactly as it appears on their birth certificate. The diploma is a legal document and must state their legal name. The deadline to submit responses has been extended to 3:00pm Friday, September 8th.
