Students Not Feeling Well

As a reminder, if your student is not feeling well, please do not send them to school. We kindly ask for them to remain home until they are 24-hours symptom free. Please contact the LCHS Attendance Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. If your student tests

positive for Covid-19, access online [Covid-19 Reporting Form](#). Once you have submitted the information for your student, a notification will be sent to Pam Brooks, LCPS CDC Rep and to LCHS. You do not need to call to report that your student has tested positive for Covid-19. Absences will be marked based on the information provided in the reporting form.

Textbook Collection-Grades 9-11

Textbook collection will take place on **Wednesday, June 7th & Thursday, June 8th** during your student's English class. Students will turn in all of their textbooks for all subjects at collection. Please remind your student(s) to have their books with them at school. **NOTE: Textbooks not turned in will result in a diploma hold at the end of your student's senior year.**

22-23 Yearbook Distribution-Grades 9-11

The 22-23 Esuerc Yearbook will be available for pick up for students who ordered a yearbook on **Thursday, June 8th**. Pick up will be during all lunches in the Commons. Please make sure your student understands the following is required in order to pick up their yearbook:

- Students **MUST** have their Student ID to pick up their book.
- Only named students on the order, or their parent/guardian living at the same address, may pick up their book unless they email me from their school email address (or Schoology) to designate an alternate pickup contact.
- Alternates must be designated by 1:20 PM on June 7th.

Late pick-ups are available during 6th hour and for the first 30 minutes after the end of school each day. Students unable to make these times will need to email [Mr. Karl](#) to make alternate arrangements.

SchoolPay

LCPS has transitioned from PaySchools to SchoolPay for parents/guardians to purchase school related items for their student. SchoolPay can be accessed through your parent portal account. NOTE: SchoolPay can only be accessed when logging on to your parent portal through a desktop computer or a browser. Logging

Visitors During School Hours

LCHS Athletic Event Policies-PLEASE REVIEW!

Please make sure to review the policies/rules for all Athletic Events in the "CLUBS/ATHLETICS" Section.

- **ALL STUDENTS MUST** have their student ID to enter any Athletic Event (or any building event outside of normal school hours). **NO ID=NO ENTRY.**
- There is an entry fee for all Athletic Events. The entry fee is for adults & students. **If your student is denied entry, they are expected to leave the premises.**
- Building entry for Athletic Events is through the front of the building only. If a spectator parks in the back parking lot, they must walk around to the front of the building for entry.
- Children under high school age **WILL NOT** be permitted into events unless accompanied by an adult. The adult is expected to stay for the entire event.

LCHS Athletic Passes/Admission Prices

There is a \$5 admission fee for all events. Children under the age of 10 & Adults age 62 & over are free. Athletic Passes from school year 21-22 are not accepted. Passes are currently available for purchase through SchoolPay.

Away Game Admission Policies

- Payment protocols vary by school. Please make sure you check the away school's website for information on how to obtain entry at their facility. Some schools require entry purchase online **BEFORE** the event.
- Students are **REQUIRED** to have their actual ID when attending an away game. Most schools **WILL NOT** accept a photo copy of an ID, picture of an ID, a coach or LCHS staff member vouching for the student or bringing up their profile in PowerSchool. Students that do not have an actual ID will not be permitted entry into the game. This is per the away school's policy.

Sports Physicals

Physical forms can be found on the [LC Athletics Website](#). A sports physical is considered valid if a parent/guardian signature appears in sections 2,3 & 4. **NOTE: Students must have a Sports Physical dated after April 15, 2023 *NOTE NEW DATE*** from this point on in order to participate in sports for the School Year 22-23.

Community Service Hours Required Per Class

Class of 2024 graduation requirement is 30 hours*

- **100 Hours must be turned in by MARCH 1, 2024** to receive the Presidential Award
- **80 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 12, 2024** to receive Honor Cord
- **30 Hours must be turned in by APRIL 26, 2024** to receive Diploma

Class of 2025 graduation requirement is 40 hours

Class of 2026 graduation requirement is 40 hours

All hours are due by the end of the student's senior year or will be subject to a diploma hold.

CLASS OF 2023:

Senior Fines/Diploma Holds

Fines that are not paid prior to graduation will result in a diploma hold for your Senior. Fines can be for, but not limited to: school textbooks, chromebooks, athletic equipment, Band/Choir/Art equipment, failure to paint over their painted parking spot, unpaid parking permit, etc. A diploma hold will be issued to Seniors that do not meet their community service requirement or curriculum requirement-**SENIORS WILL NOT RECEIVE THEIR GRADUATION TICKETS UNTIL THEIR CURRICULUM AND COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT IS COMPLETED.** **NOTE: if your Senior has a diploma hold, your student's final transcript will not be released until the diploma hold has been lifted.**

Decorating Graduation Caps

Seniors will be allowed to decorate their Graduation Cap – **PLEASE REFER TO THE [CAP DECORATING RULES](#)**. Students that do not follow the rules outlined will not be allowed to cross the stage at graduation. Please take care when decorating caps, as we do not have extra caps on hand. All seniors must be wearing a cap, tassel & gown in order to walk the stage at graduation.

Graduation

- Graduation is at Bethesda Christian Church located at 16 Mile & Schoenherr on **Friday, June 2nd**. The doors open at 6pm and graduation begins promptly at 7pm.

ceremony. **Please make sure to read through all of the information so you know what to expect for that day.**
