## Thanksgiving Holiday

On behalf of the staff at L'Anse Creuse High School, we wish our Lancer Country families a safe & wonderful Thanksgiving. As a reminder, school will be closed from Wednesday, November 23rd – Friday, November 25th. School will resume a full day on Monday, November 28th.

#### Lost & Found

If your student is missing an item, please have them stop at the tables that week. Items that are not claimed by the end of the day December 2nd will be donated.

## Students Not Feeling Well

As a reminder, if your student is not feeling well, please do not send them to school. We kindly ask for them to remain home until they are 24-hours symptom free. Please contact the LCHS Attendance

Office to report your child's absence at (586) 783-6400. If your student tests positive for Covid-19, access online Covid-19 Reporting Form. Once you have submitted the information for your student, a notification will be sent to Pam Brooks, LCPS CDC Rep and to LCHS. You do not need to call to report that your student has tested positive for Covid-19. Absences will be marked based on the information provided in the reporting form.

## Covid & Influenza Testing-Pellerin Center

L'Anse Creuse Public Schools has partnered with a clinical lab to conduct onsite testing for Covid-19 and Influenza. NOTE: Testing is temporarily unavailable and will resume again after the Thanksgiving Holiday.

## **Visitors During School Hours**

PLEASE BE ADVISED: Visitors entering LCHS during school hours (this includes parents, guardians and volunteers), must enter the building through the Commons doors. Visitors MUST stop and check-in at the Commons Desk inside the front doors to receive a Visitor's Pass before entering the main building.

## Parent Drop-Off/Pick-Up

As a reminder, the back parking lot is reserved for STAFF ONLY Monday-Friday 5:30am-3:00pm. Parent/Students are prohibited from using this parking lot during these days/times. Violators may be subject to ticketing. Also, students are to be dropped-off/picked-up in the front of the building or in the front student parking lot ONLY. Drop-off/pick-up in any other areas on or near L'Anse Creuse High School property may be subject to ticketing. ## Parking Permits

If your student drives a vehicle to school, a Parking Permit is required. Parking Permits are \$30.00 & are processed electronically only. In order for a parking permit to be issued to your student, please complete the following. Payment and all of the required

information must be submitted before a parking permit will be issued.

- Login to <u>Payschools</u> to pay for your parking permit
- Access the <u>22-23 Parking Permit Form</u>, completing the required areas and submitting pictures of the students driver's license and the vehicle registration of each vehicle that needs to be permitted.
- The parking permit will be distributed to your student during school once it is processed

Class of 2023 graduation requirement is 25 hours\*

- 100 Hours must be turned in by March 3,
   2023 to receive the Presidential Award
- 80 Hours must be turned in by April 14, 2023 to receive Honor Cord
- 25 Hours must be turned in by April 28, 2023 to receive Diploma

Class of 2024 graduation requirement is 30 hours\*

Class of 2025 graduation requirement is 40 hours

Class of 2026 graduation requirement is 40 hours

All hours are due by the end of the student's senior year or will be subject to a diploma hold.
