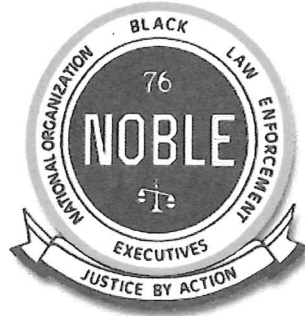

2020 APPLICATION PROCEDURES

All Scholarship Applicants must:

- **Be a United States Citizen and a resident of Michigan.**
- Be a 2020 high school graduate and have a 2.75 - 3.4 cumulative grade point average.
- Eligible applicants must be enrolled full-time in a (2) two or (4) four-year degree program at an accredited college or university for the fall 2020 term (proof of acceptance is required).
- Applicant must demonstrate a need for financial assistance. The scholarships are typically \$1,000 grants for one year.
- **Submit an official transcript.** (For current high school seniors, transcript must include grades 9-11). The transcript must cite the cumulative grade point average and must be signed by a school official with the official school seal in a sealed envelope.
- Submit (1) one current (2019/2020) signed letter of recommendation from a **non-school related community service or job related** (volunteer or work related) activity that you participated in on the organization's letterhead.
- Submit (1) one current (2019/2020) signed letter of recommendation for the NOBLE Scholarship from the **school** (i.e. teacher, principal, counselor, etc.) currently being attended on official school letterhead. You must be present in order to receive this scholarship.
 - *Persons writing recommendations should specify relationship or capacity in which they know or have observed the applicant. **Unsigned letters will not be accepted, therefore the application package will be deemed incomplete.***
- Applicant must submit a (2) page 500 word essay, doubled-spaced, typed in 12 inch font detailing future goals. Please attach a photograph with your essay.
- If applicant attends a private school, provide an explanation of the grading system on official school letterhead.
- Members of NOBLE and their family members are **prohibited** from applying for the scholarship.
- **Application must be signed by the student and parent/guardian.**
Submit application (in its original format) along with attachments, official transcripts and recommendations.

Selected finalists will be notified and scheduled for interviews after April 1, 2020. All information on this form is considered confidential. All materials become the property of the National Organization of Black Law Enforcement Executives Metro Detroit Chapter.
