Instructions:

1. Review your transcript prior to scheduling your request.

- 2. Using the Course Sheet, identify the Course Name and Course Number of the courses you would like request for next school year. Teachers and Counselors can assist you with selecting your courses.
- 3. You will be scheduling for six class periods. Four periods will be your core courses and two periods will be elective courses. Select 6-8 alternates for the elective courses you requested. Be sure to select alternates that meet your interests. If there is a scheduling conflict, you will receive an alternate course.
- 4. Courses are scheduled as one semester (one course number), full year or two semesters (two course numbers), and two periods (two course numbers).
- 5. Write the course number and course title in the spaces provided.
- 6. Teacher approval is required for ALL advanced courses. Take your course selection sheet to your current teachers to get appropriate signatures.
- 7. Please be sure to have a parent sign your Course Selection sheet approving your Course Requests, Advanced Placement Courses and/or Pankow Class.

L'Anse Creuse High School – North AP COURSE ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

AP course standards are designed by the College Board. The standards are intended to match the rigor and expectations of the college equivalent course. Our teachers have designed curriculum that teach the essential content within the standards. Therefore, AP courses are <u>fast-paced</u> and they will require the ability to <u>analyze</u> <u>and synthesize</u> information in a way that may be very challenging.

- Student-initiated learning with an emphasis on strong work ethic.
- Rigorous academic content and a high level of reading proficiency.
- More depth and complexity than typical high school courses.
- Application of content strategies.
- Consistent use of higher order thinking skills.
- Assignments are more analytical.
- High level of commitment to course work both in class and at home.

It is important to look closely at your student's total course load, outside commitments and extracurricular activities before committing to an AP course. It is typically best to begin with one AP course to see how it goes before taking on multiple AP courses at one time. Prior to registering, it would also be advantageous to speak with the AP teacher to get an idea of the expectations and essential prerequisite skills before committing.

By enrolling in an AP course you are **committing to a full year in the course!** It is important to understand that enrollment requirements and class sizes make it very difficult to offer these opportunities without requiring a full year commitment. Once you are scheduled for your AP course, we will require that you keep the course for the entire year. **Counselors cannot change AP courses!**

Student Agreement

- I agree to devote my best efforts to successfully complete the course.
- I understand this class offers increased rigor and challenge, but also increased rewards.
- I agree to communicate with my teacher if I need help, attend tutorials, and seek assistance, if I am experiencing any difficulty with course content.

- I understand and agree that a schedule change during the school year to remove an AP course will, in most cases, not be considered.
- I understand that my Counselor will not be able to alter my AP class load.

Parent Agreement
