

L'Anse Creuse Public Schools

Tomorrow is PSAT/SAT testing for 9th, 10th, and 11th graders. Testing will begin promptly at 7:11 am. If your student typically attends Pankow 1st/2nd hours, they will stay at LCN tomorrow to test. It is extremely important to be on time tomorrow. Once testing begins, rooms cannot be interrupted. Therefore, if students arrive late, they may not be able to test. Room assignments have been posted and communicated to students. Students should report to their testing room first thing in the morning. They will need to bring a photo id, #2 pencils, any wanted snacks or water, and a calculator if they have one. All other belongings should be placed in their lockers until testing ends. Please remind students to get a good night's sleep and eat something in the morning. Students should dress comfortably and in layers as temperatures in rooms may vary. Students will not be able to be called out tomorrow until the end of 3rd hour (9th and 10th grade) or 4th hour (11th grade) as we cannot interrupt testing rooms once they begin. Once testing concludes, students will follow a regular schedule including lunch with a 2:20 dismissal. Transportation to Pankow will be provided starting 4th hour when testing ends.
