

Fifth Grade Music Curriculum

Students will have access to a balanced, comprehensive, and sequential program of study in music which will, whenever possible, provide a meaningful enhancement of the classroom.

The student will:

- Sing partner songs, simple two-part arrangements and a varied repertoire of memorized music while responding to the cues of a conductor
- Perform choreography and basic folk dances
- Improvise an accompaniment or sound piece using a variety of sound sources
- Create an eight beat pattern on pitched and non-pitched instruments
- Read and play notation in various meters on the soprano recorder
- Expand knowledge of form to include rondo
- Experience examples of music from various cultures and composers
