

Per board policy, Cell phones are to be turned off and not visible during instructional time.

At MSC, we are aligning our cell policy with the other middle schools in the district. In the best interest of students and staff, we expect phones to be turned off and in lockers during school day. We have high expectations for our scholars and want a distraction free learning environment during instructional time. Students are welcome to use the office phone if they need to contact their parents during school hours.

Consequences:

Intervention 1 - Verbal Warning: staff member turns phone into office for **student** to pick up the end of the day. Parent contact made by office.

Intervention 2 - Verbal Warning: staff member turns phone into office. Parent contact made by office. **Parent** picks up phone at the end of the school day.

Intervention 3 - Verbal warning: staff member turns phone into the office. Parent contact made by office. **Parent** picks up phone and ASD (After School Detention) or LD (Lunch Detention) assigned.

Intervention 4 - Verbal warning: staff member turns phone into the office. Parent contact made by office. **Parent** picks up phone and ASD or LD assigned

Intervention 5 - Verbal warning: staff member turns phone into the office. Parent contact made by office. **Parent** picks up phone progressive discipline may apply.
